

LOS POBLANOS OPEN SPACES POLICY

To help ensure the safety, health and comfort of our staff and all visiting guests, we feel it is important to define the open spaces for each guest, while reinforcing our dedication to preservation, sustainability and, above all, community.

Defining Our Space

THE FARM – the land south of the main driveway and east of La Quinta.

THE FIELD COURTS – the area east of Campo bound by the North and South Field rooms and lavender fields.

THE SILOS – the immediate area surrounding the inn reception, Campo and the Farm Shop.

Our Guest Policy

We welcome and encourage guests who are visiting the Farm Shop, Campo and private events to wander and explore the following areas:

the Silos, the Farm, the paved road surrounding the Lotus Pond, and the south and east lawns surrounding La Quinta. We kindly ask you to reserve your visit to these areas for the respect and privacy of our Inn guests.

Inn guests are welcome in all the areas on property with the exception of the working lavender fields and the private property to the north of the distillation hut.

We kindly request that all guests respect all posted signage and do not enter service areas. This helps us ensure the safety of our staff and guests.

Visiting the Farm

Please keep in mind that Los Poblanos is a working farm with active farmers and live animals. Farmers are at work from 7:30 am until 3:00 pm and are happy to interact and tell you about the farm. The farm terrain is uneven at places. Please use caution when visiting and ensure that children under 12 have adult supervision at all times. The farm is home to an alpaca family, chickens, sheep, bees, free-roaming peacocks, geese, guinea hens and a farm cat named Mouse. At times, bird food is available by the Front Desk for the free-roamers around the Inn, but otherwise we kindly ask that you do not feed the animals as this can be dangerous to their health. To preserve and protect the work of our farmers, the Lavender Fields are off limits to guests.

Photography

Photography will be allowed in all spaces where respective guests are permitted. Commercial photography is not permitted on property without prior permission.

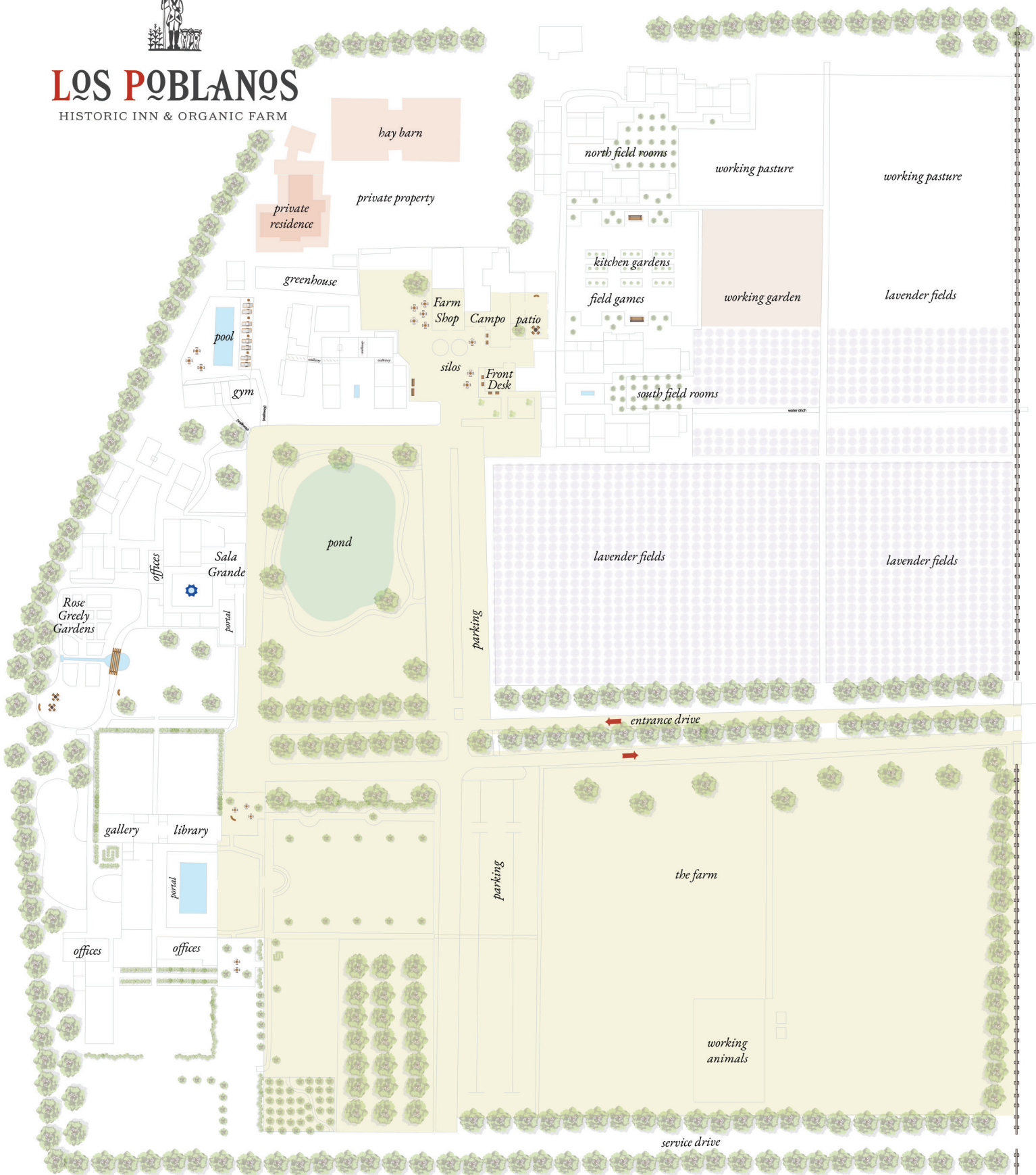
Smoking
