WINES OF NEW MEXICO

Our home of New Mexico has a lengthy tradition of winemaking. In 1629, over 130 years before the first established California vineyards, Franciscan monks were planting grapevines in the Rio Grande Valley. In the late 1800s, New Mexico was flourishing with grapevines and was on its way to becoming a successful wine region. However, in the late 1800s, devastating floods ravaged the area almost destroying all the vineyards. To make matters worse, in 1920 the industry as all but completely shut down with Prohibition. It wasn’t until fifty years later, in 1970, that the industry began to revive itself. Today we are home to the three blossoming American Viticultural Areas of Mesilla Valley AVA, Mimbres Valley AVA and Middle Rio Grande Valley AVA.

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MARTIN WOODS WINERY

Martin Woods is nestled in the oak-covered foothills of Oregon’s Coast Range, in the cool-climate McMinnville AVA of the Willamette Valley. It’s the home and winery of Evan Martin, a winemaker and vigneron driven since 2009 by a passion for uncovering Oregon’s most expressive terroirs. The focus is on elegant Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, alongside limited bottlings of Riesling, Grüner Veltliner, Gamay, Cabernet Franc and Syrah.

Evan and his small team farm sustainably and holistically, working with like-minded growers. His winemaking is gentle and natural, always aiming to express purity, balance, and complexity, hallmarks of great terroir and craftsmanship. In 2024, the Campo beverage team visited the winery to create two exclusive Los Poblanos blends: the “Campo Cuvée” Pinot Noir and Chardonnay.

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CHÂTEAU MUSAR

Château Musar wines have been a part of the Campo beverage program since its inception. Learning about the history of wine-making in the Bekaa Valley, the unique red blends and indigenous white varieties, and the Hochar family sparked a lasting fascination.

As the wine program grew, it felt important to make Château Musar a permanent fixture. While far from local, Los Poblanos shares many of the same values — growing organically, fostering biodiversity, preserving agricultural heritage, running a family business and more. Over the years, Campo menus have featured several Musar vintages by the glass, on the bottle list and as part of the Chef’s Table pairings.

Château Musar was founded in 1930 by Gaston Hochar, inspired by Lebanon’s winemaking roots and his time in Bordeaux. His son Serge, trained by Émile Peynaud, took over in 1959, guiding the winery through war and earning Decanter’s first “Man of the Year” title in 1984. Today, his sons continue the legacy.

Musar’s vineyards, in Lebanon’s Beqaa Valley, grow red grapes in the south and indigenous whites at higher altitudes. Known for its non-interventionist approach, Musar became Lebanon’s first certified organic winery in 2006.
